Abandoned Canadian National Railway Bridge, Bylaw No. 2/08

Location: southwest end of the SW ¼ 28 36 27 W3M

Registered Owner of Property: Jonathan, Loren and Sherie Ollenberger

Reason for the Designation:

- Only remaining evidence of the Canadian National Rail Line that served this areas from 1930 to 1993.
- Railway was a branch line from Unity to Bodo and served this agricultural area promoting its growth for many years.
- Architecturally unique wooden bridge, pleasing structure to view and has been photographed and painted by artists. A landmark worth preserving as a legacy for the future in memory of our past history.

The Elk School, Bylaw 1/11

Registered Owner of Property: Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No 352

Reason for the Designation:

- It is uniquely located, as it is in the middle of the Municipality and near a main highway
- Built in 1914, and is the only one-room schoolhouse located within the Municipality that is still structurally sound.
- Historically, has been a place of school, church services, dances, box socials, plays, meetings, voting poll, and sports events
- Is used as a tourist attraction, with people stopping to admire its uniqueness and appreciating its heritage as a reminder of the perseverance of the local settlers.
