


BYLAW NO. 1/86

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEART'S HILL NO. 352  
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN REQUESTING THE APPROVAL OF THE  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOARD FOR AN AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN  
THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF Heart's Hill NO. 352  
AND THE SASKATCHEWAN ASSOCIATION OF RURAL MUNICIPALITIES


WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352  
has by resolution, entered into an agreement with the Saskatchewan Association of  
Rural Municipalities dated October 7, 1986, for the purpose of providing  
liability insurance coverage for the municipality, and whereas the agreement is  
conditional upon the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352  
obtaining Local Government Board approval as to its terms and conditions:

THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352  
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The agreement hereto attached and identified as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw  
and executed by the Reeve and Administrator shall be submitted to the Local  
Government Board for approval.
2. The said agreement shall on approval of the Local Government Board and upon  
final passage of this bylaw, become binding on the parties thereto.

NOTES: This form of bylaw may be used only when a Council has entered into an  
agreement which contains a provision that the agreement is subject to the  
approval of the Local Government Board as to the financial arrangements  
contained therein. The agreement should be identified as Schedule "A" and  
attached to the bylaw. The bylaw should be given final reading and  
submitted to the Local Government Board for approval. When the bylaw has  
been completed a certified copy under seal and signature with Schedule "A"  
attached should be sent to the Local Government Board. This procedure is in  
accordance with the requirements of Section 250 of the Rural Municipality  
Act.
