

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEART'S HILL No. 352

BYLAW No. 2/06

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. The Assessor of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 is hereby authorized to dispense with the preparation of assessment notices if the assessed value of the property:

- (a) has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
- (b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
  - (i) \$1,000 from the previous year's assessed value; and
  - (ii) 1% of the previous year's assessed value.


2. Bylaw No. 2/64 is hereby repealed.

**BYLAW No. 5/06**


**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A HAYING POLICY PURSUANT  
TO SECTION 8 (1)(g) OF *THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT***


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
  - a. "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352.
  - b. "road" means a "public highway" as defined by *The Municipalities Act*.
2. Conditions for the salvage of hay from a road in the municipality:
  - a. The adjacent landowner or lessee in the case of rented land, has the first option to salvage hay along municipal roads. Other persons must contact the adjacent landowner or lessee to salvage the hay prior to July 15<sup>th</sup> each year.
  - b. After July 15<sup>th</sup>, any person may cut and salvage hay without the permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee, provided the adjacent landowner or lessee has not begun salvage operations.
  - c. The right-of-way must be left in a neat appearance by the person salvaging the hay.
  - d. Bales of hay must be at least 8 meters from the edge of the shoulder of the roadway.
  - e. All bales must be removed from the right-of-way by the 15<sup>th</sup> of August.
  - f. The Council reserves the privilege and right for its members, employees and/or agents to enter upon said right-of-way for the maintenance and or reconstruction of said roadway or for other such purposes as may be deemed necessary, and at no compensation or reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay therefrom.
  - g. The municipality assumes no liability for laborers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage of hay operations.
  - h. In order to minimize hazards to motorists, any bales not removed within one month may be removed by the municipality and any bales so removed shall become the property of the municipality.
  - i. No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality during the period from ½ hour after sunset until ½ hour before sunrise.
  - j. No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality so as to obstruct the traveled portion of a public highway.


- k. Mowing may take place by the municipality in certain areas prior to July 15<sup>th</sup> as required for control of noxious weeds, safety and aesthetic reason.
3. Bylaw No. 1/91 and Amending Bylaw No. 2/03 are hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall take effect on the day of final passing.
