

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEART'S HILL No. 352

**A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE A SITE AS MUNICIPAL HERITAGE
PROPERTY**

BYLAW No. 2/08

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of the Heritage Property Act authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 has determined that the property known as:

The abandoned Canadian National Railway Bridge located at the southwest end of the SW ¼ of Section 28, Township 36, Range 27, W3M

is a architecturally unique historical site; and,

WHEREAS not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 has:

- a. served a Notice of Intention on the Registrar of Heritage Property and all owners of property included in the proposed bylaw;
- b. published a Notice of Intention in at least one issue of a newspaper in general circulation in the municipality;
- c. registered an interest in the Land Titles Registry against all titles for the parcel of land included in the proposed bylaw; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality enacts as follows:

There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

The abandoned Canadian National Railway Bridge located at the southwest end of the SW ¼ of Section 28, Township 36, Range 27, W3M.

The reasons for the designation are as follows:

- a. Only remaining evidence of the Canadian National Rail Line that served this area from 1930 to 1993.
- b. Railway was a branch line from Unity to Bodo and served this agricultural area promoting its growth for many years.
- c. Architecturally unique wooden bridge, pleasing structure to view and has been photographed and painted by artists. A landmark worth preserving as a legacy for the future in memory of our past history.
