

BYLAW NO. 4/90.


A BYLAW PROHIBITING THE PLOUGHING AND DESTRUCTION
OF VEGETATION FROM ROAD ALLOWANCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352,
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within this municipality as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
2. No person shall plough, cultivate, or destroy the vegetation from road allowances or any portion thereof on any road in the municipality that is designated as primary grid, grid, main farm access, or special road.
3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding 250.00 dollars.
