

BYLAW NO. 1/68.

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS
IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEART'S HILL NO.
352.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No.
352 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows :

1. In this bylaw :
"road" means any road allowance within the Rural
Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 other than :
(I) a private road;
(II) a provincial highway;
(III) a road or highway within the
following hamlets, namely ;
Cactus Lake
Cosine
Heart's Hill.
2. No building shall be situated a distance of less than
150 feet from the centre line of any road.
3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than
300 feet from an intersection of roads.
4. This bylaw does not apply with respect to buildings
situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
5. Every person who causes a building to be situated in
contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an
offence and liable on summary conviction to the pen-
alties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the
Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352.

6. Nothing in section 5 hereof shall apply with respect to brush, trees or shrubs planted more than five years prior to the passing of this bylaw, where such brush, trees or shrubs :
- (a) are used as a shelter belt; and
 - (b) are situated within one hundred and fifty feet, but more than seventy-five feet, from the centre line of a road at a place other than an intersection of roads.
7. Any agent or servant of the municipality appointed by the council to carry out the provisions of sections 4 or 5 hereof shall have power for that purpose to enter upon the private property involved.
8. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the municipality while engaged in carrying out the provisions of sections 4 or 5 hereof shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by section 407 of The Rural Municipality Act.
9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section 2 hereof is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
