

BYLAW No. 9/97

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEART'S HILL No. 352 TO
REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES PURSUANT TO SECTION 206
(2)(C) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Heart's Hill No. 352 in
the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:

(a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by
the *Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84*, but shall
not include a provincial highway as designated to such
Act:

(b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by
the *Highway Traffic Act*.

2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater
than 90 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public
highway described as follows:

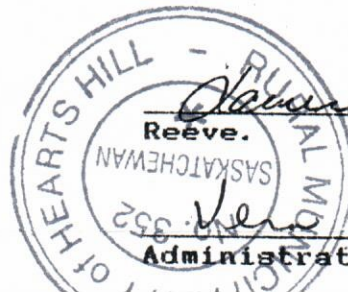
All of the paved portion of Grid No. 771 which is North of
Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, Township 36, Range 26; and
North of Sections 9, 10, 11 and 12, Township 36, Range 27, all
West of the Third Meridian.

3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at
the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be
erected showing the end of the speed zone area.

4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw
is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to
the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the
municipality.

5. This bylaw shall take effect on the day that it is approved by
the Highway Traffic Board, pursuant to Subsection 206(3) of
the *Rural Municipality Act, 1989*.

6. Bylaw No. 3/95 is hereby repealed.
